#### **Minutes of the Meeting**

**2020/016-Apologies/Attendance Register**-Apologies were received from Jon Ride and Trevor Allen.

**2020/017-Disclosable Pecuniary Interests**-Roger Gay disclosed an interest in agenda item 2020/025.1. He is a grower for the plant at Great Hele.

**2020/018-Minutes of the Previous Meeting**-The minutes were unanimously approved and signed.

**2020/019-Announcements from the Chair**-There were none.

**2020/020-Democratic 15 Minutes/Public Question Time**-Ian Bateman asked if the Council were aware of the vehicle seen in the area apparently emptying sewers. Trudy Herniman thought this was someone working on behalf of North Devon Council.

**2020/021-County Councillor's Slot**-Jeremy Yabsley sent his apologies to the meeting. He was attending another meeting.

**2020/025.1**-Reference 71093. Retrospective planning application for the formation of a lagoon for the collection of grey water in connection with the digestion process and to allow amended site area at Great Hele Barton, Condate Biogas, Alswear Old Road, South Molton, EX36 4LB.

The Councillors present unanimously supported the application.

**2020/025.2**-Reference 71068. Erection of a solar heating panel on a stand in the garden at Broom House, George Nympton, South Molton, EX36 4JF.

The Councillors present unanimously supported the application.

**2020/025.3**-Reference-71069. Listed building application for erection of a solar water heating panel on a stand in the garden together with internal and external works to dwelling at Broom House Farm, George Nympton, South Molton, EX36 4JF

The Councillors present unanimously supported the application.

**2020/027-AOB.**

Broadband-Adele Poole thanked everyone for their help in moving the broad band project to the stage where sufficient vouchers have been committed and the contract has been signed.

Adele offered to move forward and look at the feasibility of getting mobile phone coverage to our area.

Anaerobic Digester- Mark Dean has been asked about the external appearance of the site at Great Hele. The Council understand that the planting to cover the top of the building was a condition of the planning permission. The Council agreed to contact the Planning Enforcement Team to look at this matter.

Lesley Robinson raised the ongoing problems of blocked drains and potholes. Despite the issues being reported, repairs are often inadequate or not being dealt with. It was suggested that these matters should be raised with the MP.

Mark Dean told the meeting that the Village Fete will be held on 4<sup>th</sup> July. Mark asked for anyone willing to help with the planning and on fete day to let him know.
